

Agreement
Discontinuation of the Joint Master Study Programme
„Physics of the Earth“

Universität Wien, acting under the prerequisite of the Austrian Universities Act 2002 (Bundesgesetz über die Organisation der Universitäten und ihre Studien (Universitätsgesetz 2002), Federal Gazette No. 120/2002), hereafter referred to as **University of Vienna (UW)**, represented by Ao. Univ. Prof. Dr. Christa Schnabl, Vice-Rector for Educational Affairs

and the

Univerzita Komenského v Bratislave, established by the Law num. 375/1919 of the Law Digest in accordance with the Act No. 131/2002 Coll. On Higher Education Institutions, as amended hereafter referred to as **Comenius University Bratislava (CUB)**, represented by Assoc. doc. RNDr. Eva Viglašová, PhD., Vice-Rector for education and social affairs

(herein after referred to individually as the „Party“ and collectively as the „Parties“ or the „partner universities“)

agree on the discontinuation of the Joint Master Study Programme „Physics of the Earth“.

Due to persistently low student numbers, continuation of the Joint Master Programme „Physics of the Earth“ is not justified any further.

The contracting parties University of Vienna and Comenius University Bratislava agree to terminate the agreement on the Joint Master Programme „Physics of the Earth“ between the Parties and discontinue this Master programme by the end of the winter term 2026/2027.

The Parties agree that no new students will be admitted to the programme in the winter term 2024/25. All students who are enrolled in the Master Programme "Physics of the Earth" are given the possibility to complete their studies within six semesters, i.e. until the end of the winter term 2026/2027 at place of study of their choice at one of the partner universities UW or CUB.

All formal regulations contained in the agreement remain in place till termination of the Master Programme.
